

The House Budget Amendments (HB1400)

Chief Patron Wyatt

Provides \$3M to the Virginia Battlefield Fund to support the preservation of lands at the proposed Culpeper Battlefields State Park.

Chief Patron Williams

Provides \$50 K for the Mayo River State Park Feasibility Study

Chief Patron Wright

Provides \$111,334 to Cumberland County to support the completion of the Cumberland Courthouse-Bear Creek Lake connector trail.

Chief Patron Lopez

Adds \$12M this year and \$57M next year to support the operation, essential staffing, programming, and address the maintenance backlog.

Senate Budget Amendments (SB800)

Chief Patron Marsden

Provides \$15M for operations personnel for State Parks

Chief Patron Pillion

Provides \$2.2M for repairs to the swimming pool at Natural Tunnel State Park

Chief Patron Peake

Provides \$111,334 to Cumberland County to complete the Courthouse - Bear Creek Lake Connector Trail

Chief Patron McPike

Co-Patron Surovell

Adds \$34M to fund completion of Phase II and III at Widewater State Park; to include roads, trails, picnic areas, sewer, storm water, electricity, water treatment, campsites, cabins, bathhouses, and a canoe launch.

Chief Patron Reeves

Allows 2 positions to provide for over site and operation of
Culpeper Battlefields State Park \$734,127.

Chief Patron Petersen

Adds a \$5 Vehicle Registration Surcharge for State Parks

Non-Budget Legislation

HB2473

Patron Tran

This Bill provides a two-year pilot program, adding all-terrain
powered wheelchairs to State Parks for individuals with limited
mobility.

HB2151

Changes the minimum State Park Master Planning Requirements
